



Reading Mentor Role and Responsibilities 2022

Bohunt School is working to support those in our community who need to develop their reading skills. As part of this work, students in Year 7-11 will be read to by their form tutor 3 times each week as part of our literacy and reading strategy.

To support form tutors, the Sixth Form is therefore seeking to appoint Reading Mentors (voluntary, unpaid role) to read to small groups of Year 7 & 8 students during the lunchtime reading session.

Please see the roles and responsibilities below:

- Be an advocate for reading for pleasure across the school
- Liaise with tutors and Heads of House to find a placement with a tutor group
- Read the tutor group book to a selected group of students between 1.30 & 1.50 three days each week
- Talk to your small group about the book and about reading
- Feedback to the tutor any helpful information about students and their views about reading
- Abide by safeguarding training (provided by us) when interacting with main school students
